

USING YOUR KATIE BECKETT PART B BENEFITS: HRA

The **Katie Beckett HealthCare Reimbursement Account** (HRA) allows people to spend program dollars on IRS qualified healthcare expenses. The HRA for the Katie Beckett Program is Inspira.

How can I use it?

The HRA can be used two ways:

- With the provided Inspira card to pay for covered out-of-pocket medical expenses
 - Important: The card can currently only be used at medical offices such as hospitals, doctors' offices, or therapy offices.
 - When using the card, run it as credit, not debit.
- Reimbursement claims with an itemized receipt. Reimbursement requests are typically processed in 7- 10 business days. They are paid by check or direct deposit.

Information about eligible expenses can be found on Inspira's website. Common expenses include but are not limited to:

- Copays and deductibles
- Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy and Non- Traditional Therapies
- Orthotics
- Vision and Dental
- Respite (reimbursement only)
- Prescriptions (reimbursement only)

Things to know...

- Only the enrolled child is covered. The HRA is a one-time per year allocation and cannot be modified during the ISP year.
- You must submit receipts to validate every purchase.
- Some purchases need a Letter of Medical Necessity (LOMN) from a doctor to be an eligible expense.
- Credit/debit card processing fees are not a covered expense.
- You can access your account at any time via the Inspira Online Portal.
- There is a daily spending limit of \$3,200 for the Inspira card.
