- In previous guidance (a slide deck on the DoE website titled "Discussion with Directors of Schools"), the DoE indicated that it estimated there to be 322,073 students who would qualify as being "economically disadvantaged" under TISA. What is the underlying basis for this estimate (what data source) and is that number still an accurate estimate in your view?
- 2. In previous guidance (a slide deck on the DoE website titled "Discussion with Directors of

Schools"), the DoE indicated that it estimated there to be 652,039 students who would qualify as living in "areas of concentrated poverty" under TISA. What is the underlying basis for this estimate (what data source) and is that number still an accurate estimate in your view?

- 3. In previous guidance (a slide deck on the DoE website titled "Discussion with Directors of Schools"), the DoE indicated that it estimated there to be 326,549 students who would qualify as living in "sparsely populated communities" and "small school districts" under TISA. What is the underlying basis for this estimate (what data source) and is that number still an accurate estimate in your view?
- 4. In previous guidance (a slide deck on the DoE website titled "Discussion with Directors of Schools"), the DoE indicated that it estimated there to be 288,072 students who would qualify for one (1) or more unique learnings needs under TISA. What is the underlying basis for this estimate (what data source) and is that number still an accurate estimate in your view?
- 5. Related to the above, has the DoE modeled an estimate of the combined ULN weighting that will apply to the students who are expected to qualify for one (1) or more unique learnings?
- 6. Has the DoE created a model by which it is estimating funding may be curtailed under T.C.A. 49-3-108(f)? Please share the model and help me understand the math.
- 7. Please send me a copy of the TISA calculator that was sent to Knox County as an example of what has been distributed to districts across the state. It is my understanding that this model would have been pre-filled with the inputs that would be applied during the first year of TISA implementation. Is this correct?
- 8. How much of a "haircut" do you anticipate will be required in the first year of TISA implementation per T.C.A. 49-3-108(f)? 5%? 10%? 50%?

Based on a calculator I created to model potential outcomes, I am concerned that communications to date may be causing most districts to overestimate the funds they will be receiving under TISA. While I realize that it will not be possible to perfectly predict these outcomes in future years, it is my understanding (based on material published by the DoE) that we should have sufficient information to at least accurately estimate funding by district for the first year of TISA implementation (namely because it is based on prior year data that is available to us now).

Thank you for all the work you are doing on TISA and otherwise.
