SUBJECT: 2024-25 Annual Safe Schools Report

The Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) Act of 2007, now codified as Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 49-6-801-820, provides that the Commissioner of Education and the Commissioner of Safety & Homeland Security annually report to the Governor and General Assembly on implementation of the Act. Additionally, Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-4301(e) requires the commissioner to report on “the prevalence of violent and disruptive incidents in the public schools, and the effectiveness of school programs undertaken to reduce violence and assure the safety and security of students and school personnel.”

This report provides a summary of serious incidents occurring within Tennessee schools during the 2024-25 school year, as well as an overview of efforts currently undertaken to ensure the safety of our students and staff.

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Executive Summary

Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-810 requires the Commissioner of Education and the Commissioner of Safety to jointly report annually to the Governor and General Assembly on implementation and compliance with the Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) Act. Additionally, Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-4301(e) requires the commissioners to report on “the prevalence of violent and disruptive incidents in the public schools, and the effectiveness of school programs undertaken to reduce violence and assure the safety and security of students and school personnel.”

After the Uvalde tragedy on May 24, 2022, Governor Bill Lee signed [Executive Order 97](#) and initiated an Enhanced School Safety Working Group comprised of leaders within the Tennessee Department of Education (TDOE), Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security, Tennessee Department of Mental Health, Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance, Tennessee Emergency Management Agency and the Governor’s Office. This group meets monthly to determine action steps to improve school safety across Tennessee. Action steps have included developing more resources for parents to engage in school safety, increased training for schools on safety best practices, refinement of emergency operation plan templates, and increased coordination with local law enforcement.

Along with the work of the Enhanced School Safety Working Group, the Governor proposed, and the General Assembly funded, an expansion of the Office of Homeland Security to place a Special Agent in each county. In Tennessee, special agents assigned to the Tennessee Office of Homeland Security are sworn, commissioned law enforcement officers with full police powers in the state. They also receive training in behavior-based threat assessment investigations, which makes them ideally suited to help manage the threat investigations involving schools. The Office of Homeland Security began its expansion as soon as the funding was available in July 2023. By December 16, 2025, the Office of Homeland Security grew from 19 commissioned law enforcement officers to over 120. Each of Tennessee’s 95 counties is now served by a TN Homeland Security Special Agent.

School Safety Index

Serious incidents related to student behavior in Tennessee schools are tracked via TDOE’s student management information system. For the purposes of this report, TDOE has developed a measure entitled the School Safety Index, which includes those serious incidents deemed to be most directly related to the safety and welfare of students, including the following:

- Possession of a handgun
- Possession of a rifle or shotgun

- Possession of an explosive or incendiary device
- Possession of a weapon other than a firearm
- Assault of a teacher or staff member
- Assault of a student
- Sexual assault
- Aggravated assault of a teacher or staff member
- Aggravated assault of a student
- Attempted homicide
- Bomb threat

The table below indicates serious incident totals for school years 2020-21 through 2024-25. Due to the significant reduction in the number of days in which students were actually on campus as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic school closures, 2020-21 data is not comparable to previous or subsequent years' data.

To arrive at a school-level measure, the total number of the above incidents that have been reported for the school year via the student management information system is divided by a

school's average daily membership (ADM) to calculate a school safety index score. Scores for any schools reporting one or more serious incidents during the 2024-25 school year, aggregated by school district, are included in [Appendix I](#).

Using the same formula (i.e., serious incidents/ADM) to review Tennessee as a whole, the aggregate school safety index for Tennessee is presented below. Due to the significant reduction in the number of days in which students were actually on campus as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic school closures, 2020-21 data is not comparable to previous or subsequent years' data.

Emergency Preparedness

State Level Safety Team

The Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) Act establishes specific and consistent requirements for local education agencies in providing a safe school environment. The act also establishes a state-level safety team to provide guidance to school districts in their efforts to address, plan, and implement a comprehensive school safety planning strategy. This team is coordinated by the Department of Safety and Homeland Security. Products of that effort include a SAVE Act Compliance Instrument, which provides a framework for emergency planning aimed at bringing together all available resources and stakeholders to provide for the safety of all of Tennessee's students.

The School Safety Bill from 2023 (Chapter 367 of the Public Acts of 2023) transferred the State Level Safety Team to the Department of Safety and Homeland Security. The first meeting of the State Safety Team occurred on September 5, 2023, and was chaired by the Commissioner of Safety. Membership was comprised of representatives from the Department of Safety, Department of Education, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Health, State Board of Education, School Resource Officer Association, Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (now renamed the Department of Disability and Aging), along with representatives from the TN Sheriff's Association

and the TN Association of Chiefs of Police. One of the first priorities for the State Safety Team was developing and approving an Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) template for all schools to use.

School Security Assessments

[Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-4302](#) requires Tennessee public schools to conduct a school security assessment using an assessment tool developed by the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security. These assessments require public schools to evaluate safety measures throughout each campus in order to identify areas that can improve the safety and security of the school community. Assessments are completed and submitted to Homeland Security on an annual basis.

The Office of Homeland Security reviewed the submitted assessments for commonly identified vulnerabilities and recommended policy and best practices for mitigation of the vulnerabilities. Additionally, the Office of Homeland Security conducted on-site reviews of 351 school facilities, reviewed their assessment for thoroughness and accuracy, and provided recommendations to correct any identified deficiencies.

Safety Plans (Emergency Operations Plans)

As part of the SAVE Act of 2007, [Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-804](#) established specific and consistent requirements for districts related to providing a safe school environment, including the formation of district and school safety teams and requirements for the development of comprehensive safety plans. These plans, referred to as emergency operation plans (EOPs), outline how schools prepare for, respond to, and recover from natural, technological, and human-caused hazards identified within a community. A well-developed and well-documented EOP ensures that plans and procedures are comprehensive and are communicated to everyone with a potential role during emergency situations.

It is important to note the difference between a district and a school safety plan. District safety plans set the stage for school-level safety plans by providing standards and, where appropriate, uniform response protocols. District safety plans also ensure that adequate and appropriate planning occurs with the broader school community, and that district-level resources will be directed to support schools when needed. School-level safety plans provide the individually tailored planning, support, and direction needed to address the unique needs of each school.

Each district safety plan is reviewed by TDOE annually, and school safety plans are reviewed on a three-year cycle. Safety plan reviews are conducted using an evaluation rubric aligned with safety plan requirements identified in [Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-805](#). TDOE, through Regional Safety Consultants, provides feedback and guidance to districts to ensure that campuses and security

measures follow state law and to increase safety practices across the state. Regional Consultants also provide support on safety plan feedback through technical assistance, on-site monitoring visits, training, and collaborative meetings with district/school personnel, as needed. More information on Regional Safety Consultant supports is included in the *Regional Wellness and Safety Consultant* section below. During the 2024-25 school year, all 147 district safety plans were reviewed with the following findings:

Conducting Emergency Drills

Training in school safety principles provides school personnel with techniques for identifying strategies to prevent or mitigate threats and hazards, respond to emergencies, and ultimately recover from a crisis. Students are trained in emergency procedures, and emergency drills provide an opportunity to identify gaps in the training. The current drill requirements for schools are outlined in the table below:

Drill	Description
Fire Drill	Fire drills requiring full evacuation shall be held at least one (1) time every thirty (30) SCHOOL DAYS , with two (2) fire drills occurring during the first thirty (30) full days of the school year. Additionally, four (4) fire safety educational announcements will be conducted throughout the year. Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-102-137(b).

Intruder Drill	Each school shall conduct at least one (1) armed intruder drill annually. The drill shall be conducted in coordination with the appropriate local law enforcement agency. Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-807.
CPR/AED Drill	Each junior or senior high school having one (1) or more AEDs and a program of instruction on CPR in their lifetime curriculum shall schedule annual CPR/AED training for junior and high school students and conduct an annual CPR and AED drill. Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-1208.
Additional Drills	Each school shall conduct three (3) additional safety drills, not requiring full evacuation, during each school year. Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-102-137(f).

In addition to reviewing safety plans, drill logs from the 2023-24 school year were also reviewed. A total of 520 drill logs were reviewed during the most recent review cycle indicating the following:

School Safety Grant Programs

TDOE currently administers the Safe Schools Grant that is now embedded in the base formula of TISA.

Grant Program Overviews

School Resource Officer Grant

- **Purpose:** SROs provide the crucial link between schools and law enforcement agencies in their continued efforts to establish and maintain safe and secure learning environments. Beginning in the 2023-24 fiscal year, the General Assembly appropriated a total of \$140 million in recurring funds to provide a pool of funding for a Statewide SRO Program Grant. Eligible local law enforcement entities in Tennessee were able to receive grants to place one full-time, POST-certified SRO in each K-12 public school and public charter school for which they applied. Funds could not exceed \$75,000 per year, per SRO, per school for which the agency is responsible for providing SRO services. Grants may be used for expenses directly related to providing an SRO in a school, including training, salary, benefits, and equipment.
- **Awards:** For the 2024-25 fiscal year, 153 law enforcement agencies applied and received funding through the program, including participation in all 95 counties. A total of 1,368 schools were included, and a total of \$102.6 million was distributed during the fiscal year as part of the program.

Public School Security Grant

- **Purpose:** Following the tragic events at Covenant School, Governor Bill Lee and the Tennessee General Assembly included a one-time, non-recurring investment of \$40 million in public school security grants for the 2023-24 fiscal year budget. Section 3 of Chapter 4, Public Acts of the First Extraordinary Session added \$10 million for schools that did not have a School Resource Officer at the beginning of the 2023-24 school year for a total of \$50 million. This funding allocation is part of Governor Lee’s School Safety Initiative, which

puts a priority on ensuring Tennessee students have a safe school environment to learn, grow, and thrive.

- **Awards:** Grants were awarded to all districts in proportion to their relative share of the Average Daily Membership formula.
- **Appropriation:** \$50,000,000.00

Non-Public School Security Grant

- **Purpose:** Following the tragic events that occurred at the Covenant School, Governor Bill Lee and the Tennessee General Assembly included a one-time, non-recurring investment of \$14 million in non-public school security grants for the 2023-24 fiscal year state budget. This funding allocation is part of Governor Lee’s School Safety Initiative which puts a priority on ensuring Tennessee students have a safe school environment to learn, grow, and thrive.
- **Awards:** Grants were awarded to non-public schools that submitted an intent to apply in proportion to their relative share based on enrollment numbers they reported.
- **Appropriation:** \$14,000,000.00

De-escalation Training

In accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-819, de-escalation training for teachers, administrators, and other school personnel was implemented for the 2024-2025 School Year. TDOE and the Department of Safety provide support and guidance to districts through the implementation process to ensure compliance.

Teacher Discipline Act

Each year, TDOE collects signed assurances from public schools and public charter schools regarding compliance with the SAVE Act, submission of district EOPs, training requirements, and requirements of the Teacher Discipline Act. In the 2024-25 school year, all public schools and public charter schools submitted signed assurances verifying their compliance with these applicable laws and requirements.

Regional Wellness and Safety Consultants

Governor Lee established \$953,700 recurring funds for Wellness and Safety Field Positions in his 2023-24 budget. According to the budget, the funding is for nine positions to support district strategy and comprehensive services for wellness and safety. Regional Wellness and Safety

Additionally, 94.7 percent of participants strongly agree or agree that they think the training would be beneficial to others in the future.

Monitoring Visits for Emergency Preparedness

Our office conducted 108 school monitoring visits in 39 districts, ensuring each of the eight core regions of the state was monitored. Also, eight summer programs were monitored. The monitoring visit included a meeting with the safety coordinator for the district and visiting three schools within the district. A monitoring tool was created and piloted, which incorporated scenarios to assess the preparedness of the school for emergencies, as well as checking for classroom safety flip charts, emergency go buckets, marking of hard corners, and areas for sheltering in place. After each visit, the regional consultant and school safety director met with the safety coordinator about the findings of the visits and provided resources and best practices. Findings indicate more support is needed on planning for safely evacuating students and staff with mobility needs, tips, and best practices in conducting drills, conducting tabletop exercises, and determining relocation sites and reunification.

Regional Communities of Practice Calls Held

A total of twenty-four community of practice calls were held by grand region. These communities of practice calls were held monthly to address topics such as new safety legislation, best practices in emergency operations planning, new resources created, and upcoming due dates of security assessments, mandatory threat assessment reporting, and submittal of EOPs and drill logs. The communities of practice calls allowed safety coordinators to network, share best practices, and troubleshoot challenges. Each community of practice call had an agenda with information and was recorded, allowing those unable to attend the opportunity to get the information.

Transportation

Since the implementation of Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-2116, TDOE has a transportation manager overseeing training and compliance activities associated with district transportation requirements statewide. TDOE's transportation team is responsible for providing training and compliance support, as well as collaborating with the Department of Safety on the modification of school bus specifications.

TDOE also works to ensure the implementation of safety practices while students are in transit and offers guidance on best practices to enhance safety within the transportation environment.

The Department of Safety conducts at least one inspection of every public-school bus each year. In addition, the department provides and requires annual training for all "S" endorsement holders.

TDOE also monitors compliance with the requirement to display the unauthorized-entry notice on each school bus, ensuring that access is limited to authorized individuals.

To protect student safety and support accountability, each school bus must also display a clearly visible phone number in a conspicuous place, ideally on the rear bumper, so the public can report unsafe or improper operation of a school bus. This requirement helps ensure that concerns about driving behavior are quickly communicated and addressed, strengthening the overall safety of Tennessee's student transportation system.

To further support statewide safety efforts, the Department of Education collects school bus accident data and other relevant operational information. TDOE compiles and reviews crash data annually along with additional transportation metrics. More information regarding Tennessee's student transportation program can be found in [Appendix II](#).

The Road Ahead

As the Governor's Enhanced School Safety Working Group continues to meet, school safety will continue to be a priority. A particular focus for this 2025-26 school year includes increased monitoring sessions and support from regional safety consultants for each district, increased training and technical support for districts and schools across the state and continuing to ensure fidelity and compliance with behavioral threat assessment. The Tennessee Department of Education and Department of Safety and Homeland Security will continue to assess the needs of districts and schools and provide necessary tailored support through utilizing the tools and resources relevant to each agency.

Appendix I: 2024-25 School Safety Index

Description: [Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-4301\(e\)](#) states that “the commissioner shall report to the governor and the General Assembly concerning the prevalence of violent and disruptive incidents in the public schools” To fulfill this legislative mandate, the Tennessee Department of Education has developed the School Safety Index. For each school, the reported sum of serious school safety incidents is divided by the school’s average daily membership (ADM) to arrive at a percentage of enrollment or School Safety Index score. A higher index score indicates a relatively higher level of reported incidents. Schools that did not report any of the serious incidents identified below will not appear in the index:

- Possession of a handgun
- Possession of a rifle or shotgun
- Possession of an explosive or incendiary device
- Possession of a weapon other than a firearm
- Assault of a teacher or staff member
- Assault of a student
- Sexual assault
- Aggravated assault of a teacher or staff member
- Aggravated assault of a student
- Attempted homicide
- Bomb threats
