

OSHA 30-Hour General Industry

Aligned Programs of Study: All Advanced Manufacturing and Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources programs of study

Description

The OSHA 30 Hour General Industry Training course is a comprehensive safety program designed for anyone involved in general industry. Specifically devised for safety directors, foremen, and field supervisors; the program provides complete information on OSHA compliance issues. Within 6-8 weeks of successful completion of the course, participants will receive an OSHA 30-Hour General Industry Outreach, Department of Labor course completion card.

Materials, Resources, and Implementation

For OSHA recognition, the training and testing of students **must** be carried out in one of the following three ways:

1. Students use an approved online [OSHA training test owner](#) for training and test administration.

Students are taught by their classroom teacher, provided the teacher becomes a certified OSHA trainer by attending online training from the U.S. Department of Labor at <https://www.osha.gov/dte/outreach> or onsite training at Volunteer State Community College OSHA Training Center. The Volunteer State Community College OSHA Training Center is the only OSHA approved training site in Tennessee. Registration Procedures for Online Testing

The school must purchase a voucher number or access code for each student or a site license from an authorized online training provider.
