Aligned Program of Study: Nursing Services

Description

The Certified Nurse Aide is a nationally known credential in nursing care and is a key stepping stone in career advancement for patient care providers. The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1987 (OBRA 1987) required states to initiate and maintain Nurse Aide Training and Competency Evaluation Programs and Nurse Aide Registries. The Act was designed to improve the quality of care in long-term health care facilities and to define training and evaluation standards for nurse aides who work in such facilities. The CNA credential allows a student to enter the health care field as a certified health care provider and is required, by law, for all nurse aide practitioners in Tennessee.
