

Natural Hair Stylist License

Aligned Program of Study: Cosmetology

Description

A person who uses techniques which result in tension on hair strands such as twisting, wrapping, weaving, extending, locking, or braiding of the hair by hand or mechanical appliances, which work does not include the application of dyes, reactive chemicals, or other preparations to alter the color or straighten, curl or alter the structure of the hair. The techniques include providing or offering to the general public for compensation any of the following services solely for development or improvement of physical qualities of the natural hair structure: intertwining in a systemic motion to create patterns in a three-dimensional form; inversion or outversion flat against the scalp along the part of a straight or curved row; or extension with natural synthetic fibers.
