Description

<u>Intuit QuickBooks</u> is a leading managerial accounting software package used by small businesses, entrepreneurs, contract accountants, and large businesses. Careers in finance require the ability to use bookkeeping software programs to apply fiscal tracking and data entry tasks, and the database management skills required to successfully operate within the <u>Intuit QuickBooks Certified User (QBCU)</u> software program can be easily transferable to other managerial accounting programs.

The QuickBooks Certified User exists in two versions: an online version and a desktop version. The online version tests students on new features found in the QuickBooks Online software, including receipt capture from a mobile device, cloud-based app support, work from anywhere on any device, instant file access for accountants, and schedule and sends invoices automatically. The desktop version tests students on basic accounting knowledge and utilities of the QuickBooks Desktop software, including pre-built sample companies, multiple company files, annual updates, and data backed-up and restored. The desktop software is a one-time download with industry-specific features and reporting.
