Description

Microsoft Technology Associate (MTA) is an introductory Microsoft certification for individuals considering a career in technology. MTA certification addresses a wide spectrum of fundamental technical concepts, assesses and validates your core technical knowledge, and enhances your technical credibility. To become a Microsoft Technology Associate, you must pass the **MTA Software Development Fundamentals** exam in the MTA Developer track. Students only need to pass this exam to become MTA certified. However, there are additional exams students can choose to further their training. MTA certifications allow students to explore career options in IT and validate their understanding of core concepts in IT infrastructure, databases, and software development. Each MTA certification can be earned in one semester and can be used to demonstrate your ability and commitment when applying for above entry-level IT positions.
