

Occupational Educator Licensure

Occupational Licensure Overview

In accordance with <u>Educator Licensure Rule 0520-02-03-.04</u>, occupational licensure includes endorsements in occupational content areas that are focused on preparing students in career and technical content areas (*Health Science 6-12*, *Cosmetology 6-12*, *Distribution & Logistics 6-12*, *etc.*). Occupational endorsements can be granted on an Emergency Credential, known as an **Occupational Permit** or, on an **Occupational Teaching License**. There are two levels of occupational licensure, **Practitioner 3-Year** (initial-level) and **Professional 6-Year**.


Occupational Permits

Occupational permits are valid until June 30 following the date of issuance and cannot be renewed. An individual may only be issued **one** (1) occupational permit. Occupational permit applications must be submitted by the requesting district on behalf of the educator with documented evidence of a targeted recruitment strategy. **Please note: some occupational areas may require the instructor of record to hold an active industry certification for students to be able to sit for any certification/exam at the end of the course. ^{*}Note: Most occupational endorsements require an active industry certification. Currently, there are three occupational areas that do NOT require an active industry certification: Broadcasting, Public Health, and Supply Chain Management.



Occupational Teacher Renewal, Advancement, and Reactivation

Practitioner Renewal

To renew a practitioner occupational license, an educator must:

- a. **Practitioner Occupational 1st issuance:** Complete an approved educator preparation program prior to the end of the validity period of the issuance of the practitioner license.
- b. Practitioner Occupational:
 - Earn thirty (30) qualifying professional development points as defined in the Educator Licensure Policy 5.502; and
 - Hold an active industry certification for the area of endorsement as defined by the department, if applicable.

If the requirements for practitioner license renewal are not met prior to the end of the validity period of the practitioner license, the license shall become inactive.

Professional Occupational Teacher License Renewal

To renew the professional occupational teacher license educators must meet the following requirements:

- a. Earn sixty (60) <u>professional development points</u> or two (2) years' experience within the license validity period as indicted by SBE <u>Educator Licensure Policy 5.502</u>; **and**
- b. Provide verification of an active industry certification for the area of endorsement as defined by the department, if applicable.

If the educator has not met the requirements for renewal at the end of the validity period of the professional license, then the license shall become inactive. Inactive licenses must be reactivated.

Advancement

To advance from a practitioner occupational teacher license to a professional occupational teacher license, an educator shall meet one of the following sets of requirements:

- 1. Option 1:
 - (a) Complete three (3) years of qualifying experience as an educator as defined by the department;
 - (b) Complete a State Board-approved educator preparation program;
 - (c) Earn thirty (30) <u>professional development points</u>, a minimum of twenty (20) which shall come from new teacher training provided by the department as indicated by SBE <u>Educator Licensure Policy 5.502</u>; and
 - (d) Hold an active industry certification for the area of endorsement as defined by the department, if applicable.

2. Option 2:

- (a) Holds a full and valid professional-level occupational license from a state other than Tennessee that is a partner in the NASDTEC interstate agreement; **and**
- (b) Holds an active industry certification for the area of endorsement as defined by the department, if applicable.
- 3. Option 3:
 - (a) Holds a full and valid professional-level Academic Tennessee license; and
 - (b) Holds an active industry certification for the area of endorsement as defined by the department, if applicable.

Reactivation

An occupational teacher license may be reactivated by meeting the following requirements:

- (a) Hold an active industry certification, as determined by the department, for the area of endorsement, if applicable; or
- (b) If the endorsement area does not require a certification, then have a minimum of five (5) years of relevant work experience, completed within the last ten (10) years, or three (3) years of relevant work experience, completed within the last give (5) years, in the area of endorsement or equivalent education attainment as defined by the department; **and**
- (c) Meeting one (1) of the following requirements:

Adding Occupational Endorsements

Teachers who hold an active professional occupational teacher license may add additional occupational endorsements through one (1) of the following pathways:

- 1. Hold an active industry certification, as determined by the department, for the area of endorsement, if applicable; **or**
- 2. If the endorsement area does not require a certification, then have a minimum of five (5) years of relevant work experience, completed within the last ten (10) years, in the area of endorsement or equivalent education attainment as defined by the department.

Educators who hold an academic teaching license and are pursuing occupational licensure must meet the industry certification or work experience requirements of the area of endorsement sought.

American College of Sports Medicine, Certified Clinical Exercise Physiologist credential is required. **Radiologic technologists, nuclear medicine technologists, and diagnostic medical sonographers are not required to be licensed to practice in TN, but must have a degree in radiologic technology AND a national certification from the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists to practice and be eligible for a Health Science endorsement. Radiology and sonography certificates that are "add-ons" for other allied health professionals are not equivalent. **EMT/Advanc
