

### What is it?

Education is not one-size fits all, and some students may benefit from a new or different learning environment.

The **Education Savings Account (ESA) program** is a scholarship for eligible students to use to attend participating nonpublic schools. The scholarship can be used for educational expenses such as tuition, textbooks, technology, and uniforms.

# Who can apply?

Any student who is zoned to attend a Memphis-Shelby County School, Metro Nashville Public School, Hamilton County School, or a school in the Achievement School **District**, and is entering grades K-12. Additional eligibility requirements can be found on the website below.
