Assessment and Accountability

- Will the Department continue to provide updates related to assessment to the district testing coordinators? What is the best way for other district leaders to remain informed?
 - RESPONSE: The department will be sending bi-weekly updates on assessments to the District Testing Coordinators through the existing email listserv, as well as providing a monthly DTC webinar. Additionally, updates will be referenced in the Commissioner's Update for Directors and posted on the assessment LiveBinders site.

- Should districts close school playgrounds to the public?
 - RESPONSE: This is a local decision and one that can be different from community to community. The Department recommends school districts consult with school board attorneys, the school board, community leaders and, the local health department before making the decision. These groups can assist districts in best determining the needs of the community.
