<b>May 30 – June 30</b>	Appeal Window	Per State Board of Education rules, an appeal can be submitted by a parent or legal guardian to the Department within fourteen (14) calendar days of receipt of the notice from the LEA or public charter school that the student is identified as at-risk for retention based on the student achieving a performance level rating of approaching on the ELA portion of the student’s most recent TCAP test.
<b>June 7</b>	All 3 <sup>rd</sup> Grade ELA TCAP Retake Scores Reported	Regardless of the district’s selected dates for retake administration, all districts will receive results of the TCAP retake within 48 hours.
<b>June 13</b>	Summer Camp Post-test Opens	Adequate growth calculations will be returned within five business days of the administration of the post-test.
<b>June 24</b>	Final Retention Notification for Families (Not Participating in Intervention Pathways)  *This is for families who <u>did not</u> participate in the intervention pathways.	This date applies for schools starting July 24. If school starts later, notification to families must be disseminated at least 30 days before the first day of school.
<b>July 14</b>	Final Retention Notification for Families (Participating in Intervention Pathways)  *This is for families who participated in the summer programming intervention pathway.	This date applies for schools starting July 24. If school starts later, notification to families must be disseminated at least 10 days before the first day of school.



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
