I am in receipt of your letter requesting a waiver of the class size average for Career and Technical Education classes found in T.C.A. §49-1-104 for Robertson County Schools for the 2017-2018 school year.

The commissioner's waiver authority under T.C.A. § 49-1-201(d) is limited by T.C.A. §49-1-104(a), which states that "neither the commissioner nor the state board of education shall grant waivers from the maximum class sizes established in this section."

With the understanding that none of the Career and Technical Education classes in the Robertson County School District will exceed 25, the maximum number of students per class specified in the above referenced law, your request for a waiver of the class size average is granted for the 2017-2018 school year.
