Dear Mr. Cox:

I am in receipt of your September 24, 2018 letter requesting a waiver of the class size average for seventh and eighth grade classes found in T.C.A. §49-1-104 at Centertown Elementary School for the 2018-2019 school year.

The commissioner's waiver authority under T.C.A. §49-1-201(d) is limited by T.C.A. §49-1-104(a), which states that "neither the commissioner nor the state board of education shall grant waivers from the maximum class sizes established in this section."

With the understanding that none of the seventh and eighth grade classes at Centertown Elementary School will exceed 35, the maximum number of students per class specified in the above referenced law, your request for a waiver of the class size average is granted for the 2018-2019 school year.

Centertown Elementary School, seventh / eighth grade is over the class size requirement by .50. Currently there are 122 students in seventh (67 students) and eighth grade (55 students) served by four teachers. This calculates to 30.50 students (class size). To prevent disruption of the school's current grade level alignment, a waiver is requested for class size requirement.
