Introduction

The Tennessee Department of Education (department) releases this report annually to comply with requirements established in T.C.A. § 49-16-104. It provides information on the operation of public virtual programs for the 2024-25 school year, which includes enrollment data, academic performance outcomes, and an overview of virtual school funding. The report includes data for public virtual schools and their establishing local education agencies (LEAs) during the 2024-25 school year. Virtual School Quick Facts for 2024-25

- The number of public virtual schools has remained stable since 2021-22 with 59 schools operating in Tennessee for 2024-25.
- Enrollment in Tennessee public virtual schools increased to 14,337 students in 2024-25, up from 12,630 students in 2023-24.
- In 2024-25, 27 percent of public virtual schools earned a school-wide TVAAS composite of Level 3 or higher, compared to 66 percent of non-virtual schools.

Virtual Education Landscape

Tennessee law and State Board of Education (SBE) rule 0520-01-03-.05 allow virtual education to be delivered through two models:

- Public virtual schools: The LEA establishes a virtual school which is separate from any other LEA established schools and is identified under its own school number.
- Virtual education programs: An existing school within the LEA offers virtual coursework options to students.

These models provide alternatives to the traditional classroom setting but are still subject to all the statutory and regulatory requirements that govern public education in Tennessee.

Establishment of Virtual Education

The Tennessee General Assembly established the state's virtual education framework in two stages. In 2008, the General Assembly enacted Chapter 1096 of the Public Acts of 2008, codified in Title 49, Chapter 16, Part 1, which authorized LEAs to use state education funds, seek grant funds, and accept donations to implement virtual education programs. In 2011, the Tennessee General Assembly enacted the Virtual Public Schools Act, codified in Title 49, Chapter 16, Part 2, which authorized LEAs to establish public virtual schools. Pursuant to T.C.A. §§ 49-16-102 and 49-16-215, the State Board of Education adopted rules governing the establishment and operation of public virtual schools and virtual education programs. The Act also established that public virtual schools are public schools and must receive the same resources as other public schools in Tennessee. T.C.A. § 49-16-204.

Models of Virtual Education

As indicated above, SBE Rule 0520-01-03-.05 allows for two models of virtual education: public virtual schools and virtual education programs.

A public virtual school is a school established by an LEA that uses technology to deliver a significant portion of instruction through the internet in a virtual or remote setting. An LEA may operate a public virtual school directly or contract with an outside provider to manage or operate the school. In all cases, the establishing LEA remains directly responsible for the school's performance and compliance.

A virtual education program is a course or series of courses that an LEA or public charter school offers through technology to provide students with a broader range of educational opportunities. A student may participate in a virtual education program without enrolling in a public virtual school. The student remains enrolled in the school where the student receives the majority of instruction during the school year.

Operation of Public Virtual Schools

Before opening a public virtual school, an LEA must submit the documentation required through the Tennessee School Directory (TNSD). Through that process, the LEA must assure that the proposed school's academic and operational practices will comply with the Virtual Public Schools Act and SBE Rule 0520-01-03-.05.

An LEA may staff a public virtual school with LEA employees or contract with another entity to manage or staff the school. Regardless of the staffing model, each course must have a teacher of record who holds the appropriate Tennessee educator license and endorsements for the course. The establishing LEA remains responsible for ensuring that the school operates in compliance with applicable law and rules.

Public virtual schools must provide access to a sequential curriculum aligned to Tennessee academic standards using state-approved instructional materials, provide 180 instructional days and 6.5 instructional hours per day, administer required state assessments in a proctored environment, and undergo annual evaluation by the establishing LEA. Public virtual schools must also ensure that students with disabilities, English learners, and other students with unique learning needs are not excluded from enrollment and receive the services required by the student's individual education program (IEP), Section 504 Plan, or individual learning plan (ILP). LEAs may use state, local, and federal funds, where allowable, to establish and operate public virtual schools and virtual education programs.

Use of Virtual Education Programs

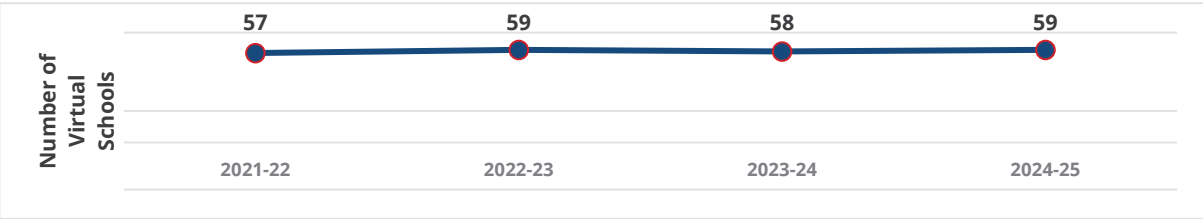
Under SBE Rule 0520-01-03-.05, LEAs and public charter schools may use virtual education programs for academic remediation, enrichment, broader course access, continuity of educational service for homebound students, continuity of service for quarantined students, continuity of educational service for students enrolled in an alternative school, work-based learning and internships, advanced coursework, and credit recovery. Participation criteria remain at the discretion of the LEA or public charter school.

In most cases, coursework delivered through a virtual education program may not constitute the majority of a student’s instructional time during a school semester. The rule allows exceptions for students who temporarily receive all instruction virtually under specific circumstances, students who participate in work-based learning or internships during regular school hours, students who access advanced coursework virtually, and students who take virtual coursework for credit recovery.

Public Virtual Schools by the Numbers

According to the TNSD data, the number of public virtual schools operating in Tennessee has remained stable in recent years as seen in figure 1. During the 2024-25 school year, 59 public virtual schools operated across 52 LEAs.

Figure 1. Public Virtual Schools Operating Over Time



Data from the annual virtual school monitoring reports, which are conducted by the LEAs and submitted to the department for review, show that public virtual schools vary by enrollment type. During the 2024-25 school year, 26 schools (44%) limited enrollment to in-district students, 23 schools (39%) offered a statewide enrollment option, and 10 schools (17%) offered in-district enrollment with limited out-of-district enrollment in surrounding areas. LEAs may offer out-of-district or statewide enrollment, but state law does not require them to do so.

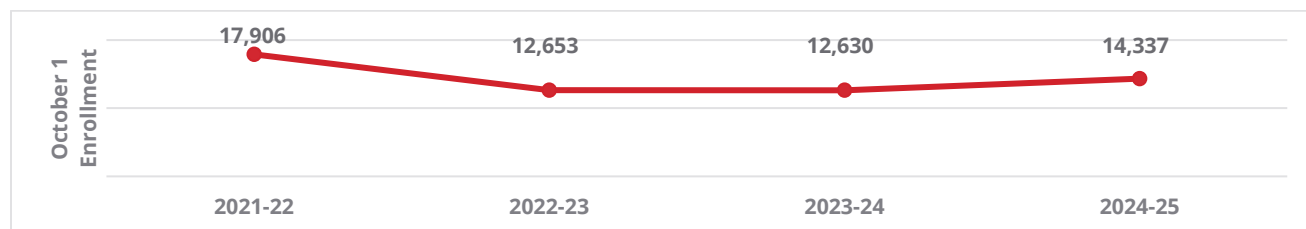

Student Enrollment

Information collected through the Tennessee Education Data System (TEDS) shows an increase in public virtual school enrollment to 14,337 in 2024-25, which is up from the previous two years but below the peak enrollment of 17,906 in 2021-22. Figure 2 shows public virtual school enrollment from 2021-22 through 2024-25.

Accountability

Public virtual schools are subject to the same accountability framework as all other public schools in Tennessee. T.C.A. § 49-16-213 imposes additional accountability requirements based on school-wide student growth, as measured by the Tennessee Value-Added Assessment System (TVAAS), and state-defined school designations. The department publishes accountability results on the [Tennessee State Report Card](#) and assigns [School Letter Grades](#) and school designations to eligible public schools, including public virtual schools. Pursuant to Chapter 905 of Public Acts of 2026, if a public virtual school earns a school-wide TVAAS composite of Level 1 for three consecutive years, beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, or meets the state's Priority school criteria, beginning with the first priority school list released after the 2025 priority school list, the establishing LEA must close the school at the end of that school year.

Academic Outcomes

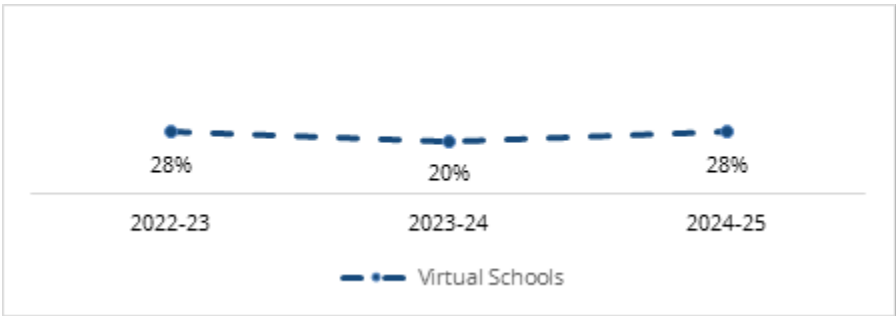
According to the 2024-25 state accountability data, students in virtual schools showed improvement in English language arts (ELA). In ELA, 29% of students in public virtual schools that met or exceeded expectations, up from 22% in 2023-24. In math, 14% of students scored *on track* or *mastered*, a slight decrease from 15% in the previous year.

The Tennessee Value-Added Assessment System (TVAAS) shows that 27% of public virtual schools earned a schoolwide TVAAS composite score of Level 3 or higher in 2024–25, an increase from 21% in 2023–24.

School Letter Grades

The Tennessee school letter grade system provides parents and families with information about public school performance across the state. The department assigns letter grades on a scale from A to F based on student achievement, student academic growth, growth of the highest-need students, and college and career readiness for high schools. In 2024-25, 28 percent of virtual schools earned a letter grade of A through C, which is an increase from 20 percent in 2023-24. Figure 9 shows the percentage of schools that earned a letter grade of A through C over time. [Appendix G](#) provides the letter grade earned by each eligible public virtual school.

School Designations

Each year, the department identifies schools for recognition or support under Tennessee’s accountability framework.

Reward Schools

Three public virtual schools earned Reward School status based on 2024-25 accountability scores. Reward schools demonstrate high levels of performance or improvement in performance. Table 2 lists the public virtual schools that earned a Reward School designation.

Priority Schools

Four public virtual schools were identified as Priority schools based on 2024-25 accountability scores. Priority schools are schools that earn performance scores in the bottom five percent of all Tennessee public schools, exhibit a graduation rate of less than 67 percent, or exhibit chronically low-performing student subgroups that do not improve after receiving additional targeted support. Priority schools receive school turnaround interventions and support from the department to develop evidence-based school improvement plans. Table 3 lists the public virtual schools that earned the Priority School designation.

Funding

Public virtual schools receive the same funding and resources as other public schools in Tennessee. LEAs may use state and local funds, as well as federal funds, where applicable, to establish and operate public virtual schools and virtual education programs. [Appendix H](#) provides the Tennessee Investment in Student Achievement (TISA) funds generated by each operational public virtual school in 2024-25.

Actions Taken to Strengthen Virtual Education in Tennessee

LEAs are responsible for the performance of the public virtual schools they establish. The department supports LEAs through technical assistance, guidance, and implementation support. LEAs monitor and evaluate each public virtual school annually using the department's standardized virtual school monitoring framework. The monitoring framework requires LEAs to evaluate each virtual school's academic, fiscal, and operational performance. LEAs must publicly report the results through a department template on both the LEA and school websites and distribute the results to enrolled families.

1. LEAs create extensive plans and supporting resources for each public virtual school prior to opening. The department provides materials and guidance to help LEAs address required local decisions, including board approval, instructional modality, attendance, truancy, academic intervention, enrollment, special populations, teacher of record requirements, professional development, technology access, and state testing.
2. T.C.A. § 49-6-2202 requires the Tennessee Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission to develop a plan to review electronic textbooks and instructional materials for use by virtual schools.

Conclusion

Tennessee provides two virtual education models, but the enrollment and outcome data provided focus solely on public virtual schools. Public virtual school enrollment has remained stable for the past three years, and the percent of virtual schools earning a letter grade of A through C increased to 28% in 2024-25. Three public virtual schools earned Reward School status, and four were identified as Priority schools.

Oversight of virtual education programs is the responsibility of the establishing LEA, and the department provides support and guidance through monitoring tools, public reporting templates, technical assistance, and updated guidance to support

local oversight. The department will continue to support LEAs as they improve the quality of their public virtual schools for Tennessee’s students and families.

Level 4	Above Average Effectiveness: Moderate evidence that the school's students made more progress than the Growth Standard (the school's index is between 1 and 2).
Level 5	Most Effective: Significant evidence that the school's students made more progress than the Growth Standard (the school's index is 2 or greater).

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
