

2024-25 TCAP Assessment Reporting Protocol

Last updated: June 2025

This document describes business rules applied when preparing the 2024-25 Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program (TCAP) District Results and State Results. It is important to note that these business rules are different from the rules applied in accountability reporting.¹

Non-public school testing records are excluded from the reporting.

1. Testing records are assigned to schools and districts in which they are tested (50 percent enrollment rule is not applied).
2. English Learner (EL) students who recently arrived in the United States are not included in these data.
3. Among middle school students who took both the TCAP and End of Course (EOC) exams, EOC data are used.
4. TCAP Alt Assessments are excluded from the TCAP dashboard reporting.
5. Student demographic information is based on the information in the Education Information System (EIS) on the last day of the spring testing window.
6. The percent below expectations performance level is calculated after the rounding process to ensure that all percentages sum to 100. Percent below expectations = $100 - (\text{percent exceeded expectations} + \text{percent met expectations} + \text{percent approaching expectations})$.
