- 1. FCS failed to provide instruction from an appropriately licensed teacher.
- 2. FCS failed to provide speech services outlined on Student's IEP.
- 3. FCS failed to provide a related service progress report.

Description of the law or regulation determined to be violated:

34 C.F.R. §300.101 FAPE

34 CFR 300.320(a)(3)(ii) Definition of individualized education program – periodic reports

Fayette County Schools must correct these violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

- 1. Within 10 days of receipt of this letter, FCS is required to convene an IEP meeting to determine the need for compensatory education services for all missed IEP service and related service hours.
- 2. The signed written compensatory education agreement, complete with Complainant's signature, must be submitted to the department after the IEP meeting required by Student Level Correction #1.
- 3. FCS is required to train on the periodic/progress reporting requirement and submit evidence to the department by January 15, 2022.
- 4. FCS is required to evaluate the impact of the lack of personnel on each impacted student specific to their provision of FAPE, including the students enrolled in the classroom and each student served by the departed related service provider;
- 5. Evidence of this evaluation is to be submitted to the department by January 15, 2022;
- 6. FCS is required to communicate these evaluation results to parents upon completion and submit evidence of parental communication to the department;
- 7. FCS is required to convene IEP meetings within 10 days of this evaluation for any student identified in District Level Correction #3 to determine the need for compensatory education services for all missed IEP service and related service hours.
- 8. If applicable, the signed written compensatory education agreements, complete with parental signature(s), must be submitted to the department by January 15, 2022.

Final determination of the department: The department will monitor and document Fayette County Schools compliance with corrective measures ordered.
