Name of the school system:

Metro Nashville Public Schools (MNPS)

Description of the violation:

MNPS failed to conduct child find procedures in a timely manner.

Description of the law or regulation determined to be violated:

34 C.F.R. § 300.101	Free appropriate public education (FAPE)
34 C.F.R. § 300.111	Child Find
SBE Rule 0520-01-09-.05	Child Find and Free Appropriate Public Education

The district must correct these violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

1. MNPS must train NCCS on child find and the need for additional assessments or evaluations.
2. MNPS must offer repayment of any funds spent on an outside evaluation, including travel reimbursement for mileage to and from the facility.
3. MNPS/NCCS must convene a Student Support Team meeting within 10 (school) days of receipt of this determination letter.
 - a. a. If a disability is suspected, the LEA must evaluate, determine eligibility, and consider the need for special education and compensatory education services.
 - b. b. If no disability is suspected disability, the LEA must provide parents a prior written notice, (clearly outlining the refusal and reason(s) for the refusal) and procedural safeguards.

Final determination of the department: The department will monitor and document the district's compliance with corrective measures ordered.
