

IDEA WRITTEN ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Name of the school system:

Rutherford County Schools (RCS)

Description of the violation:

RCS failed to conduct an IEP meeting in a timely manner.

RCS failed to implement IEP services not implanted as written.

RCS failed to provide access to inspect and review educational records in a timely manner.

Description of the law or regulation determined to be violated:

34 C.F.R. § 300.323(c)	When IEPs must be in effect.
34 C.F.R. § 300.613(a)	Access rights
SBE Rule 0520-01-09-.12(4)	Individualized Education Program (IEP) Requirements

RCS must correct these violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

- 1) RCS must review and determine any educational impact from missed inclusionary services.
 - a) If the missed inclusionary services had an educational impact, RCS must offer to convene an IEP meeting to discuss any compensatory services or remedies due to missed inclusionary services.
- 2) RCS must train appropriate staff on the aforementioned regulations.
- 3) Upon completion, RCS must provide evidence of corrective actions 1. and 2. to dispute.resolution@tn.gov

Final determination of the department: The department will monitor and document the district's compliance with corrective measures ordered.
