Name of the school system:

Rutherford County Schools (RCS)

Description of the violation:

IEP services were not implanted as written.
An IEP meeting was not held in a timely manner.

Description of the law or regulation determined to be violated:

34 C.F.R. § 300.323(c)(2) When IEPs must be in effect.
SBE Rule 0520-01-09-.12(4) Individualized Education Program (IEP) Requirements

The district must correct these violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

1. RCS must review and determine any educational impact from missed services.
 - a. If the missed services had an educational impact, RCS must offer to convene an IEP meeting to discuss any compensatory services or remedies due to missed inclusionary services.
2. RCS must monitor make-up sessions through completion.
3. Upon completion, RCS must provide evidence of corrective actions 1. and 2. to dispute.resolution@tn.gov.

Final determination of the department: The department will monitor and document the district's compliance with corrective measures ordered.
