The LEA must return the student to the placement from which the student was removed, unless the parent and the LEA agree to a change of placement as part of the BIP modification.

See 34 C.F.R. § 300.530(f)(2)

The LEA must conduct an FBA and implement a BIP for the student. If a BIP has already been developed, the LEA must review and modify the BIP to address the behavior.

See 34 C.F.R. § 300.530(f)(1)

Note: An LEA may remove a student to an interim alternative educational setting for up to 45 school days regardless of the outcome of the manifestation determination review if the child (1) possesses a weapon, (2) possesses drugs, or (3) inflicts serious bodily injury on school property or at a school event. 34 C.F.R. § 300.530(g)

School personnel and at least one of the student's teachers must determine the extent to which services are needed to enable the student to continue to participate in the general education curriculum and to progress toward meeting the goals set out in the student's IEP. See 34 C.F.R. § 300.530(d)(4)
