	WIDA ACCESS files available to districts	<p>This release includes school- and district-level WIDA ACCESS files through the Accountability application. 	Grade 2 Assessment files available to districts	<p>This release includes student-, school-, and district-level assessment files through the Accountability application. These files are not to be reported publicly and are to be used by districts only for informative purposes and not subject to appeals.</p>
	Chronic Absenteeism files available to districts	<p>This release includes student-, school-, and district-level Chronic Absenteeism files through the Accountability application. These files are used to calculate the Chronically Out of School indicator; thus, these files are embargoed through Sept. 1.</p> <p>These data are subject to appeals beginning Aug. 19 and ending Sept. 1.</p>
	2020 Graduation Rate files available to districts	<p>This release includes student-, school-, and district-level files through the Accountability application. These files are used to calculate the Graduation Rate indicator; however, these files are not subject to appeals, as these data were finalized in September 2020.</p> <p>These files are embargoed through Sept. 1.</p>

	2020 <i>Ready Graduate</i> files available to districts	<p>This release includes student-, school-, and district-level files through the Accountability application. These files are used to calculate the <i>Ready Graduate</i> indicator; however, these files are not subject to further appeals. These files are embargoed through Sept. 1.</p> <p>These files are embargoed through Sept. 1, have already undergone appeals through the <i>Ready Graduate</i> appeals process and are not subject to further appeals.</p>
	Substitution files available to districts (if applicable) ¹	This release includes a student-level for applicable districts file through the Accountability application detailing where 11 th grade ACT/SAT scores were used with the Achievement indicator rating. These files are embargoed through Sept. 1 but are not subject to appeals.
Aug. 19	TVAAS Evaluation and Subject Composite Files	<p>This release includes school- and district-level accountability files through the Accountability application. These files detail the metrics for each indicator and preliminary grades and designations; thus, these are embargoed through Sept. 1.</p> <p>These data are not subject to appeals beginning Aug. 19 and ending Sept. 1.</p>

Sept. 7-20	2021 District Report Card Preview Window	Districts will have this preview window to preview the staging site for the 2020-21 Report Card to review their data, ask questions, and make appeals. Appeal for any data non-accountability related data presented on the Report Card are due Sept. 20 at 5 p.m. CT.
Sept. 23	2020-21 Report Card Release	The 2020-21 Report Card will include accountability data finalized after the appeals window which closes Sept. 20.

Milestones dates are estimates and are intended to provide guidance around when to expect results. However, the production of TDOE files is determinant on vendor delivery, and these dates may be adjusted accordingly.*
