

## 2018-19 TNReady English Language Arts Grade 2 Assessment Overview

### English Language Arts (ELA) Assessment Overview

This fact sheet provides information about the optional English language arts assessment in grade 2. The grade 2 assessment is an optional test districts can choose to administer. The assessment provides valuable data to third grade teachers, ensuring younger learners are strengthening foundational literacy skills.

The ELA assessment assesses the Tennessee Academic Standards through literary and informational texts and requires students to demonstrate the ability to read closely, analyze text, answer text-dependent questions, provide a written response to a prompt, and demonstrate command of the English language.

The ELA assessments are administered in four subparts and measure comprehension, foundational literacy skills and fluency, language conventions, grammar, spelling, writing, and listening.

### Performance Levels and Scale Scores

Student performance on Tennessee’s statewide assessments is categorized into four performance levels.

Table 1 provides information regarding student achievement at each performance level for the TNReady ELA tests. This information is provided on student reports so that students, parents, and educators may interpret student results in a meaningful way.

Performance at this level demonstrates that the student has a minimal understanding and has a nominal ability to apply the grade/course-level knowledge and skills defined by the Tennessee Academic Standards.	Performance at this level demonstrates that the student is approaching understanding and has a partial ability to apply the grade/course-level knowledge and skills defined by the Tennessee Academic Standards.	Performance at this level demonstrates that the student has a comprehensive understanding and has a thorough ability to apply the grade/course-level knowledge and skills defined by the Tennessee Academic Standards.	Performance at this level demonstrates that the student has an extensive understanding and has an expert ability to apply the grade/course-level knowledge and skills defined by the Tennessee Academic Standards.
