

In autumn 2025, the Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (APC) will start engaging stakeholders to gather feedback from the public and industry about a potential fee increase for certain Non-Title V (NTV) air pollution sources (conditional major and true minor sources).

The fees in the Non-Title V program have not increased in over 14 years; however, operational expenses have increased in that time. APC is exploring ways to increase revenue to keep pace with rising expenses. APC is evaluating fee increases for construction permit application fees, annual emission fees, Conditional Major permit review fees, and other potential fees.

We want to hear from you and welcome your input on the consideration of fee increases for certain NTV air pollution sources. TDEC will offer various opportunities for public engagement- including webinars, meetings, and online comment cards. We encourage your participation and input to help develop the best, sustainable solution.

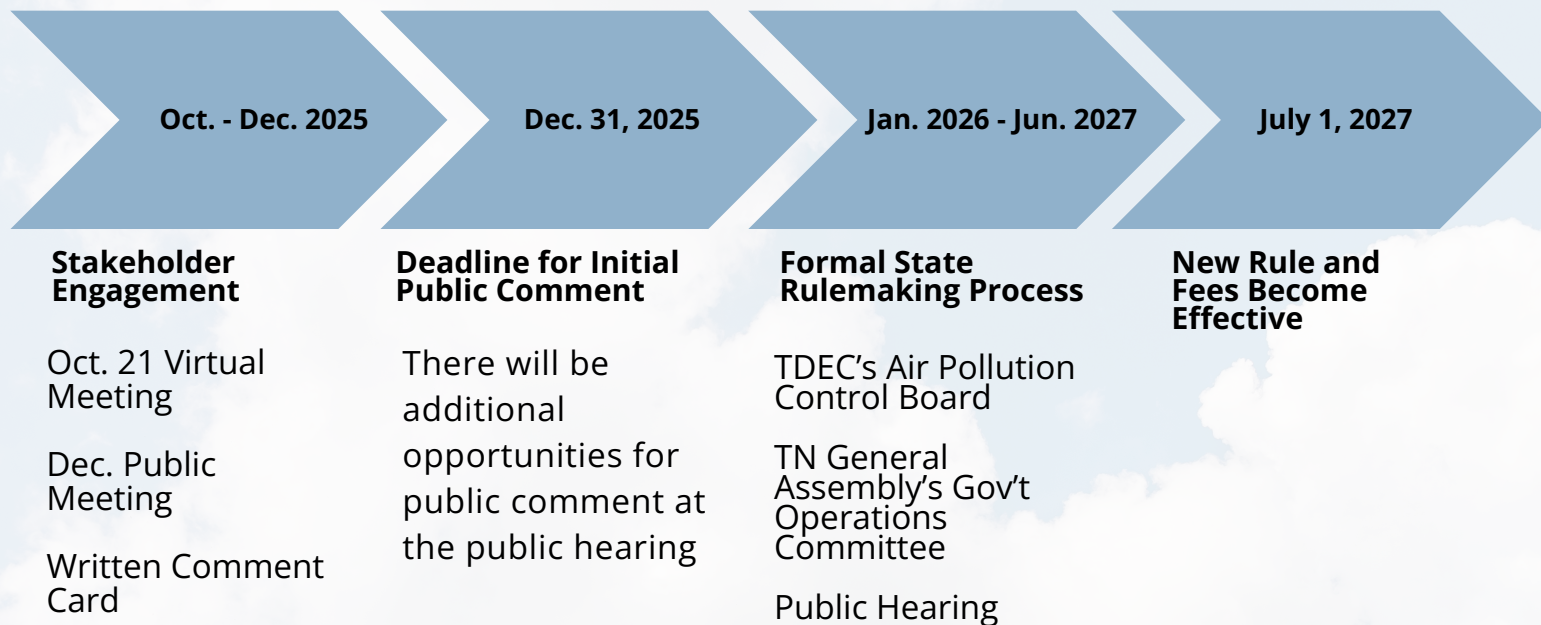
