

## **PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE**

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has received an application from Titan Partners, LLC (Facility ID: 22-0222 / Permit No. 978165) for construction of a new bulk petroleum terminal located at I-40 at I-840, East of Hogan Road, in Burns, TN 37029. The proposed operation consists of a petroleum terminal with pipeline and metering station, three truck loading bays with ethanol, gasoline, and distillate, five internal floating roof gasoline storage tanks, and one fixed roof distillate storage tank. Vapor recovery units are used for air pollution control. There will be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. J. Pratt is the assigned Division person.

In accordance with the current State of Emergency and State and Federal directives and guidance to avoid social and recreational public gatherings of 50 or more people and to practice social distancing, TDAPC will hold the public meeting described in this notice, via video-teleconference. This public meeting is being conducted via video-teleconference in the interest of protecting public health, safety, and welfare in light of the coronavirus. Because this public meeting is held pursuant to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (TAPCR) 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h), the meeting will have a question and answer format and will include a presentation on the proposed permit action by staff from TDEC's DAPC, TDEC's Division of Water Resources (DWR), and TDEC's Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM). Information on how to join the online public meeting is provided below. Those without internet access may join by phone. In addition, written comments may be submitted in the manner described below.

Based on initial public comments received by the DAPC, a multi-Division public meeting will be presented online by DAPC, DWR, and DSWM via a WebEx conference on Wednesday, July 8, 2020, at **5:00 p.m. CST**. The videoconference will open to participants at **4:45 p.m. CST**. Participants may join by computer online, via the WebEx app, or by phone. Participants are highly encouraged to join by computer online or with the WebEx app in order to view pictures and other content, which will be shared by DAPC, DWR, and DSWM.
