

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications August 17, 2020. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications will be published on the following dates: August 19-20, 2020. Public notices are generally published every week. The previous publication of public notices was August 6, 2020.

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mrs. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. The applicant is Summers-Taylor Material Company – Mooresburg Concrete Plant with a mailing address of 300 West Elk Avenue, Elizabethton, TN 37644. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 37-0081-01/978397) for the modification of a Concrete Batch Plant Operation located at 135 Moreland Road, TN 37811. This existing operation consist of one storage (cement/fly ash) silos, conveyors, and filter cartridges used to produce ready mix concrete. Fabric filter bags from silo vents are used for pollution control. The requested modification is the addition of a storage silo to the concrete plant. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Mr. J. Horton is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC dba Springfield Quarry with a mailing address of 115 East Park Drive, Suite 100, Brentwood, TN 37027. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 74-0009-03/978373) for the modification of an Ag-Lime Crushing and Sizing Operation located at 4275 Highway 431 North, Springfield, TN 37172. This existing

operation consists of a crusher, screen, conveyors, and associated equipment used for crushing and sizing rock material. The requested modification is to increase production rate. Wet suppression is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Ms. T. Kefauver is the assigned Division person.

They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 83-0530-01/978436) for construction of a Concrete Batch Plant located at 109 Long Dr. Millersville, TN 37072. This operation consists of two silos, cement batcher, truck load out station and associated equipment used for dry mix concrete. Fabric filters would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. T. Kefauver is the assigned Division person.

This operation consists of a compounding weigh up station and two mixing lines. An exhaust filter is used for air pollution control. There would not be any physical construction.
