

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications August 24, 2020. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications will be published on the following dates: August 25-27, 2020. Public notices are generally published every week. The previous publication of public notices was August 13, 2020.

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mrs. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. The applicant is Greene County Highway Department with a mailing address of 795 Hal Henard Road, Suite 1, Greeneville, TN 37743. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 30-0249-02/78367) for a Gasoline Dispensing Facility located at 798 Hal Henard Road, Suite 1, Greeneville, TN 37743. This existing operation consists of one underground gasoline storage tank and associated gasoline dispensing equipment. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. H. Flores is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Rogers Group, Inc.- Pottsville Asphalt with a mailing address of 421 Great Circle Road Nashville, TN 37228. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification

number: 59-0065-02/978422) for the modification of the Drum Mix Asphalt Plant located at 646 Tennessee 11 Lewisburg, TN 37091. This operation consists of a drum mixer, with asphalt and shingles recycle circuit for making hot mix asphalt. The requested modification is to update emission limits by using most updated emission factors published in AP-42 from EPA for the hot mix asphalt plant. A baghouse is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Ms. T. Kefauver is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Diageo Americas Supply, Inc. dba Cascade Hollow Distilling Company with a mailing address of 1950 Cascade Hollow Road, Tullahoma, TN 37388. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 16-0009-18/978442) for modification of a Whisky Maturation Warehousing Operation located at the same address. This existing operation consists of 15 whisky maturation warehouses. The requested modification is to add one additional warehouse which would increase the barrel capacity of the warehousing operation from 330,000 barrels to 350,513. Because of the type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. J. Dolzen is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Crematory Care Center Inc. dba Petcare Cremations with a mailing address of P.O. Box 7733, Kingsport, TN 37664. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 82-0607-01/978435) for construction of a natural gas fired cremation unit located at 1221 Stewball Circle, Kingsport, TN 37664. This proposed operation would consist of a cremation unit to incinerate human remains. Natural gas would be used for fuel. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Jim A. Attar is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Maryville College with a mailing address of 502 East Lamar Alexander Parkway, Maryville, TN 37804. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification

number: 05-0117-03/978404) for construction of two natural gas-fired boilers at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of two 300 HP natural gas-fired boilers. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. J Dolzen is the assigned Division person.
