Public notices are generally published every week. The previous publication of public notices was June 17, 2020.

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mrs. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. The applicant is Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) - Gallatin Fossil Plant with a mailing address of 1499 Steam Plant Road, Gallatin, TN 37066. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 83-0025-27/978221) for construction of an air curtain incinerator at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of a combustion chamber, air blower, and associated equipment to dispose of wood and other vegetative waste from land clearing activities. An air curtain incinerator functions as an air pollution control device as an alternative to open burning. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. J. Fuss is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Scepter, Inc. with a mailing address of 1485 Scepter Lane, Waverly, TN 37185. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 43-0006-50\_/978314) for construction of an ammonia air stripping system at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of installation of a landfill leachate ammonia stripping system into both existing leachate collections tanks. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. ## **PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE**

Volunteer Sand and Gravel, LLC (Facility ID: 43-0120 / Permit No. 978163) has applied to the Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) for construction of a Sand and Gravel Operation to be located in Humphreys County at 25 Burned House Road, Hurricane Mills, TN 37078. The proposed operation would be a wet process consisting of screens, conveyors and associated equipment used for the sizing of rock material. Wet suppression would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. T. Kefauver is the assigned TDAPC person.

In accordance with the current State of Emergency and State and Federal directives and guidance to avoid social and recreational public gatherings of 50 or more people and to practice social distancing, TDAPC will hold the public meeting described in this notice, via video-teleconference. This public meeting is being conducted via video-teleconference in the interest of protecting public health, safety, and welfare in light of the coronavirus. Because this public meeting is held pursuant to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (TAPCR) 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h), the meeting will have a question and answer format and will include a presentation on the proposed permit action by TDAPC staff.
