The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mrs. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. The applicant is ConAgra Foods Packaging Foods, LLC with a mailing address of 96 Pinnacle Drive, Jackson, TN 38301. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 57-0078- 01, 07, 13, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, & 22 / 978286) for the construction of a frozen sandwich production line located at the same address. The facility's existing operation consists of a 9 MMBtu/hr. natural gas-fired direct contact water heater (source 01), ammonia refrigeration system (source 07), two 8 MMBtu/hr. natural gas-fired indirect-heat fryers (source 13), one 15 MMBtu/hr. natural gas-fired direct contact water heater (source 15), and one 6 MMBtu/hr. natural gas-fired commercial pizza oven (source 16). Emission limitations for existing sources 01, 07, 13, 15, and 16 will be revised. The new operation will consist of two pita ovens (sources 18 and 19), a 157 hp diesel-fired emergency fire pump engine (source 20), a flour receiving operation (source 21), and a dough mixing operation (source 22). Air pollution control equipment is associated with the new operation. There will be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. J. Pratt is the assigned Division person.

They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: (53-0222-01/978351)) for construction of a natural gas fired cremation unit at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of a cremation unit to incinerate human remains. Natural gas would be used for fuel. There would be physical construction.
