The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mrs. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. The applicant is Minth Tennessee International, LLC with a mailing address of 935 Aulerich Road, East Tawas, MI 48730. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification numbers: 59-0168-[01-09] / 978295) for construction of an Automotive Parts Manufacturing Facility to be located at 1801 Childress Road, Lewisburg, TN 37901. This proposed operation would consist of chrome and nickel decorative plating lines, a paint line, copper tanks, stripping tanks, and associated equipment. Wet Packed Bed Scrubbers, Composite Mesh Pad Scrubbers (wet scrubbers), Mist Eliminators, HEPA filter, and a Regenerative Thermal Oxidizer (RTO) would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. G. Forte is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC dba Bristol Quarry with a mailing address of 3001 Alcoa Highway, Knoxville, TN 37920. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 82-0206-01/978584) for the modification of a Rock Crushing and Sizing Operation located at 1516 Highway 11-W, Bristol, TN 37620. This existing operation consists of

crushers, screens, conveyors, and associated equipment used for crushing and sizing rock material. The requested modification is to increase production rate. Wet suppression is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Ms. T.
