These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications will be published on the following dates: October 06, 2020. Public notices are generally published every week. The previous publication of public notices was September 30, 2020.

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mrs. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. The applicant is Iconex LLC with a mailing address of 5512 East Morris Blvd., Morristown, TN 37813. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 32-0018-32/978552) for the installation of an ETI Coater Converter Machine located at the same address. This existing operation consists of equipment used to manufacture coated film for various applications. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. S. Deloach is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Royal Canin U.S.A., Inc. with a mailing address of 920 Arctic Drive, Lebanon, TN 37087. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 95-0118-15, 17, 22, 23, & 24/978512) for the modification of the pet food production and packaging facility located at the same address. This existing operation consists of a raw ingredient processing line (source 17) and two dry pet food production lines (source 15). Fabric filters and cyclones are used for air pollution

control. The requested modifications consist of including air aspiration systems to the coaters associated with two existing dry pet food production lines (source 15) and constructing the following new lines: a raw ingredient processing line (source 22), pet food regrind line (source 23), and two dry pet food production lines (source 24). Fabric filters and cyclones will be used for air pollution control on the new lines. There will be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. J. Pratt is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is IMI Tennessee, LLC with a mailing address of 5024 New Nashville Hwy, Murfreesboro, TN 37129. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 60-0126-01/978558) for modification of a Concrete Batch Plant located at 758 Beechcroft Road, Spring Hill, TN 37174. This existing operation consists of a two silos, cement batcher, truck load out station and associated equipment used for mixing concrete. The requested modification is to replace a silo and increase production rate. Cartridge fabric filters and fabric filter baghouses are used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Ms. T. Kefauver is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Boral Resources LLC, with a mailing address of 815 Maurice Dr., Cedar Park, TX 78613. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 81-0061-01/978554) for construction of a Fly Ash Transloading Operation to be located on Industrial Park Blvd., Cumberland City, TN 37050. This proposed operation would consist of a portable fly ash transloader to convey fly ash from tanker trucks to railcars. A fabric filter would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. T. Blake is the assigned Division person.
