

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Construction permits issued by TDAPC do not grant any authority to operate, construct, or maintain any installation in violation of any law, statute, code, ordinance, rule, or regulation of the State of Tennessee or any of its political subdivisions.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Hankook & Company ES America Corp. with a mailing address of 1325 International Boulevard, Clarksville, TN 37040. The applicant seeks to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 63-0385 and 84091) for construction at the following address: 1325 International Boulevard, Clarksville. The permit request is for the following: Removal of the following operations: Grid Casting (Source 01), Lead Oxide Manufacturing (Source 02), Mixing and Pasting (Source 03), Three-Process Operation (Source 04), Curing and Drying (EP14 of Source 05), and Plate washer and two Central Vacuum Units (Source 06 – never constructed). Addition of the following operations: New Formation 1 and Dilution Tanks (Source 10), New Formation 2 (Source 11), Battery Reliability Test Lab and Dilution Tanks (Source 12), and New Finishing – Final Cover Sealing (Source 13). Wet scrubbers and mist eliminators will be utilized to control emissions of particulate matter, lead, sulfur dioxide, and sulfuric acid. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source.
