This modification would include the construction of two additional surface coating spray booths, three natural gas-fired bake ovens, one paint kitchen, and one paint mixing room. Fabric filtration is proposed to control pollutant emissions from the spray booths. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by the existing emission source and would be emitted from the new emission units/activities.
