The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) identified a mathematical error in the established emission limits for this permitted source while processing the operating permit renewal. In order to correct this error, the emission limits must be increased. TDAPC has elected to process this operating permit renewal as a combined construction/operating permit in order to correct the emission limits. The combined construction/operating permit is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period.
