

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to air.pollution.control@TN.gov or Ms. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, Davy Crockett Tower, 7th Floor, 500 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within 30 days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Construction permits issued by TDAPC do not grant any authority to operate, construct, or maintain any installation in violation of any law, statute, code, ordinance, rule, or regulation of the State of Tennessee or any of its political subdivisions.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Volunteer Paving LLC with a mailing address of 750 Highway 99, Lewisburg, TN 37091. The applicant seeks to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 74-0523 and 84188) for construction at the following address: Industrial Drive, White House. The permit request is for construction of the following: Astec double barrel drum mixer (continuous mix), asphalt cement storage, aggregate stockpiles, reclaimed/recycled asphalt pavement (RAP), and associated equipment used to produce hot mix asphalt (HMA). Baghouse control would be the emissions control device used for controlling air contaminants being emitted while the asphalt plant is in operation. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source.
