TN Multi-Sector Permit (TMSP) re-issuance

- The TMSP is a general permit issued by the Division of Water Resources (DWR) every 5 years for industrial stormwater runoff. The TMSP expires on June 30, 2025; DWR has already public noticed the draft revised permit and hosted the public hearing. Awaiting issuance of final permit.
 - General changes in the new TMSP.
