ENFORCEMENT OVERVIEW

- The Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) issued three Hazardous Waste Orders and no Solid Waste Orders between August 1, 2025, and November 14, 2025.
- There are no updates from the previous Board hearing.

Orders Issued – Signed

- Fac. ID No. TND048120570/APCOM Inc., Williamson County.
 - HWM25-0016 Directors Order
 - Signed October 15, 2025.
 - Inaccurate HW determination, weekly inspections, container labeling, waste stream notification, contingency plan, quick reference guide and HW reduction plan.
 - Civil Penalty \$6,300.00 and Damages \$1,825.76.
 - Within 30-day response window.
- Fac. ID No. TND006387880/Waymatic Inc., Obion County.
 - HWM25-0010 Directors Order
 - Signed October 22, 2025.
 - Failure to conduct HW determination, weekly inspection, employee training, annual report deficiencies, used oil and universal waste
 - Civil Penalty \$6,300.00 and Damages \$1,254.28 paid November 5.
 - Case is closed.

Orders Issued – Signed

- Fac. ID No. TND987788668/Terrepower, LLC, White County.
 - HWM25-0008 Directors Order
 - Signed October 31, 2025.
 - HW determination, weekly inspection documentation, excess waste accumulation and storage, waste stream reporting, and contingency plan.
 - Civil Penalty \$18,200.00 and Damages \$5,121,38.
 - Within 30-day response window.
