# Settlement Update

- **City of Memphis**
  - Settlement Agreement signed January 12, 2022
  - Agreement settles outstanding past costs through December 31, 2021 for five DOR sites
    - City agreed to pay \$110,000 in two payments prior to January 31, 2022 and July 29, 2022.
- **Shelby County**
  - Cost recovery settlement has been reached. Settlement Agreement is being routed for signatures.
- DOR continues to work with the City of Memphis and Shelby County to reach an agreement on outstanding remedial work at several sites.

  - Attorney General's office filed complaint seeking judicial enforcement of final order in Davidson County Chancery Court on January 11, 2022
  - Failure to pay registration fees and solvent surcharges, submit outstanding documents
  - Civil penalty of \$13,800
- **DOR90-3442 David Witherspoon, Jr. and US Department of Energy**
  - Screen Arts, Knox County, DOR site ID 47-530
  - Matter referred to the Attorney General's Office
  - Working with respondent to address the site
