New Rule Implementation

Closure/Post Closure Plan Resubmittal

- New rules established Dec 30, 2019 requires active Class I and II landfills to resubmit closure/post-closure plans every 10 years including the development of a "long term custodial care plan".
- Initial correspondence will be sent to Class I facilities this Fall 2020
- For Class I Facilities, the Division is requested a timetable be submitted for this requirement by December 31, 2020, with the actual resubmittal due by June 30, 2021
- No action taken on Class II facilities yet.



Annual and Triennial Engineering Reports

- Class I landfills due May 1st of every year
- Class II landfills due May 1st every third year
- 2020, TDEC gave extensions until August 1st
 - No enforcement for 2020
 - Facilities that submitted by May 1st, 2021 will be deemed compliant with the regulation.



Annual and Triennial Engineering Reports

- Only (2) Class I landfills with an "operating" status have not reported in <u>either year</u> to date:
 - McMinn County Landfill
 - Bolivar/Hardeman Landfill
- NOV's were issued to May 15th for those facilities that have not reported for the 2021 year.
- Division has developed a "Annual Engineering" inspection program to formally review the reports.
- 32 of 43 Class II reports have been received.




Financial Assurance Updates

- Division is currently reexamining all county and municipal contracts in lieu of bonds on file to ensure the Closure and Post-Closure values reflect 3rd party costs consistent with industry standards.
- Joint project with OGC, Division of Financial Assurance, OEA and DSWM.
- Part of a larger initiative to make sure that all permit, private and public, have sufficient financial assurance. (Related to Closure/Post-Closure Plan resubmittal requirements)
- 144 on file to be examined.



Financial Assurance Updates

CONTRACT OF OBLIGATION IN LIEU OF PERFORMANCE BOND (CILB) DSWM PROCESS FLOW STATUS



Finished (1) means only standard yearly inflation adjustment required

Finished (2) means the amount on file was found to be not sufficient to execute closure and/or post-closure and a permit adjustment was issued.



Special Waste Update

- Currently beginning our recertification season
 - Implemented a refined process for tracking all permits across the state.
 - Better controls in place to turn applications around in a shorter timeframe.
 - Weekly checks on all permit statuses are being performed by the Central Office.



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
