

Division of Solid Waste Enforcement Update

Underground Storage Tanks and Solid Waste Disposal Control Board December 7, 2022

ENFORCEMENT OVERVIEW

- The Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) issued four Hazardous Waste Orders and no Solid Waste Orders between July 19, 2022, and November 19, 2022.
- From the previous Board meeting, one Hazardous Waste Order requires an update.

HW Director's Order - Closed

Summary of Hazardous Waste Order HWM21-0001

Fac. ID No. TND007024672 /The Chemours Company, Shelby County

- Signed July 15, 2022
- Order issued for rule violations including:
 - Failure to properly label and manage HW containers
 - Failure to store HW in containers
 - Storage of HW for greater than 90 days
- Upfront Civil Penalty \$8,750.00
- Damages \$1,312.50
- Order was still within 30-day timeframe.
- Payments were processed on August 23, 2022 and the case was closed.



HW Director's Order - Final

Summary of Hazardous Waste Order HWM22-0003

Fac. ID No. TNR000003863 /MANAR TennPlasco LLC, Macon County

- Signed August 4, 2022
- Order issued for HW violations including:
 - Failure to conduct HW determinations
 - Failure to notify on waste stream generation
 - Failure to conduct weekly inspections
- Upfront Civil Penalty \$7,700.00
- Damages \$3,807.00
- Referred to Fiscal Services for Invoicing



HW Director's Order - Final

Summary of Hazardous Waste Order HWM21-0020

Fac. ID No. TNR000038075 /Phoenix Medical Products, Johnson County

- Signed August 15, 2022
- Order issued for rule violations including:
 - Failure to notify on waste stream generation
 - Failure to use HW manifests
 - Failure to use permitted transporters
- Upfront Civil Penalty \$11,000.00
- Damages \$1,169.00
- Referred to Fiscal Services for Invoicing



HW Director's Consent Order - Closed

Summary of Hazardous Waste Order HWM22-0022

Fac. ID No. TN0000879809/UT-Main Campus, Knox County

- Signed August 22, 2022
- Order issued for rule violations including:
 - Failure to maintain aisle space
 - Failure to properly label and date HW storage containers
 - Failure to label and properly store Universal Waste
- Upfront Civil Penalty \$12,170.00
- Damages \$4,581.00
- Payments were processed on August 25, 2022 and the case was closed.



HW Director's Order - Closed

Summary of Hazardous Waste Order HWM21-0001

Fac. ID No. TNR000020230 /Tradebe Transportation, Shelby County

- Signed October 6, 2022
- Order issued for rule violations including:
 - Violation of 10-Day Transfer Rules
- Upfront Civil Penalty \$5,100.00
- Damages \$1,162.00
- Payments were processed on October 31, 2022 and the case was closed.
