FY 24-25 Grants

- Used Oil: Sept. 1, 2023
 - \$600,000 total
 - \$86,850 per grant
- Convenience Center: Sept. 1, 2023
 - \$350,000 total
 - \$50,000 per grant
- Recycling Equipment/Recycling Rebate: Jan. 1, 2024
 - \$500,000 total
 - \$60,000 per grant
- Household Hazardous Waste: Jan. 1, 2024
 - \$150,000 total
 - \$30,000 per grant



FY 24-25 Grants

- Composting/Organics Management: CY 2024*
 - \$300,000 total
 - \$100,000 per grant
- Education and Outreach: CY 2024*
 - \$100,000 total
 - \$10,000 per grant
- * These grants are pending due to lack of staff
- Applications open ~ four months prior to grant start date
