## HB0667/SB0438 Solid Waste Task Force

(b) The task force must be composed of fifteen (15) members, as follows:

(1) The governor, or the governor's designee;

(2) The chair of the energy, agriculture and natural resources committee

of the senate, or the chair's designee;

(3) The chair of the committee of the house of representatives with jurisdiction over subject matters pertaining to solid waste disposal, or the chair's designee;

(4) Six (6) individuals appointed by the speaker of the senate; and

(5) Six (6) individuals appointed by the speaker of the house of

representatives.
