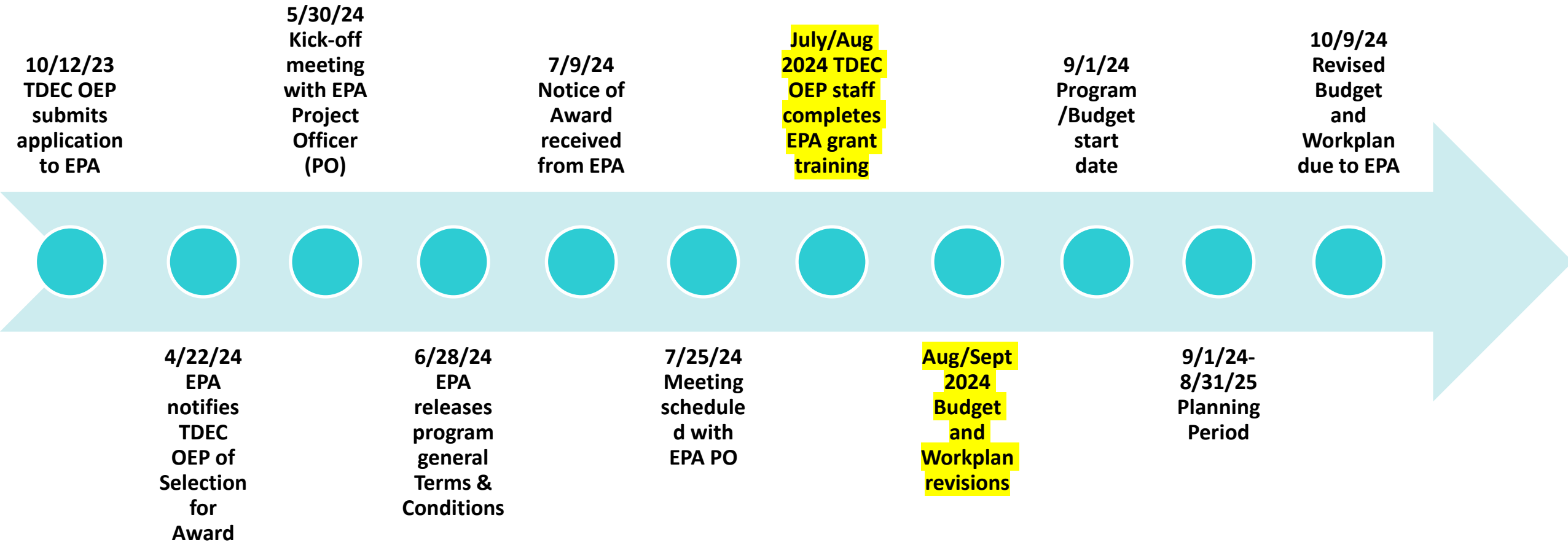
Recent Updates

- TDEC OEP posted the job position for the Energy Program Administrator for the Tennessee Solar for All Program
 - Applications must be submitted through www.tn.gov/careers
 - The posting closes on **August 26**

Ongoing Efforts

- Engagement with EPA Project Officer
 - Discussions regarding David-Bacon Act Compliance
- Engagement with the Clean Energy States Alliance (CESA)
- Participation on the Leadership Team for the National Association of State Energy Office's Solar Working Group
- Completing mandatory EPA Grant Recipient training
- Creation of Quality Assurance Project Plans
- Budget and Workplan revisions in alignment with new guidance and Special Terms and Conditions
 - Both items are due to EPA 90 days after the Notice of Award (10/9/24)
 - TDEC OEP is still awaiting feedback from EPA on a few specific questions
- TDEC OEP plans to work with TVA, KUB, and Knoxville's Community Development Corporation to complete a prospective multi-family housing example "sketch" in the coming months
