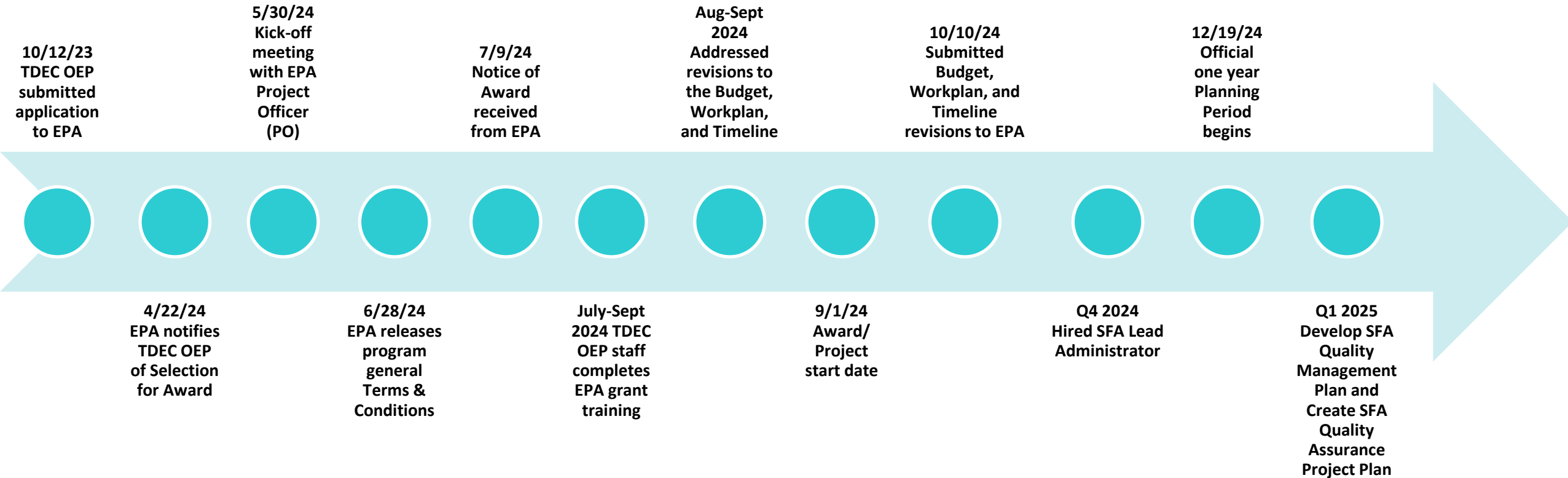
Progress Updates

- Welcome the Tennessee Solar for All Lead Administrator
- EPA approved the Tennessee's Solar for All Amendment #1 documents (Workplan, Budget, and Timeline) on December 18, 2024
 - **This kicks off the official one-year planning period**
- Quality Management Plan (QMP) and Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP)
 - TDEC has **90 days** to develop and submit both a QMP and a QAPP
 - The QMP must first be submitted/approved by EPA before the QAPP can be submitted and then reviewed/approved by EPA
 - TDEC OEP is working with staff from the Bureau of Environment and Office of General Counsel on the QMP and QAPP
- TDEC OEP staff have been participating in the EPA's weekly Solar for All Reporting Working Group
 - The first report due to the EPA must be submitted by January 30, 2024

Progress Updates Continued

- EPA has posted a BABA General Applicability waiver for public comment
 - Comments are due December 28
 - <https://www.epa.gov/system/files/documents/2024-12/epa-proposed-solar-waiver-oggrf-sfa.pdf>
- TDEC intends to release a **Notice of Intent to Participate** in early 2025 for Local Project Implementation Teams and the Statewide Program
 - TDEC and Milepost have been reconnecting with Core Team from the original application to the EPA
- Stakeholder Meetings will be rescheduled in 2025
