
AFVs in Emergencies



AFVs in Emergencies

- Alternative Fuel Vehicles
 - Diverse fleet allows for multiple options in the event of an emergency
 - Dedicated fueling source in many instances
- Example: Atlantic City Jitneys and Hurricane Sandy
 - Minibuses ("Jitneys") run on natural gas used during Hurricane Sandy to perform critical services
