Guidelines for Letter of Credit

{Required Wording for Letter of Credit to Meet the Bonding Requirements For Plugging and/or Reclamation of Oil and Gas Wells Permitted by the State Oil and Gas Program of The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation pursuant to Tennessee Rule Chapter 0400-52-01-.05(5). The letter of credit must be worded as follows, except that instructions in parenthesis are to be replaced with the relevant information and the parenthesis deleted. The letter of credit should be submitted on bank letterhead.}:

- 1. Your sight draft, bearing reference to this letter of credit No._____, and,

- 3. The original letter of credit.

This letter of credit is effective as of (insert: <u>date</u>) and shall expire on (insert: <u>date of one year later</u>), but such expiration date shall be automatically extended for a period of one year on the expiration date (insert: <u>initial expiration date</u>) and on each successive expiration date unless, at least 120 days before the current expiration date, we notify you by certified mail that we have decided not to extend this letter of credit beyond the current expiration date. In the event you are so notified, any unused portion of the credit shall be available upon presentation of your sight draft for 120 days after the date of receipt by you, as shown on the signed return receipt.

Whenever this letter of credit is drawn on under and in compliance with the terms of this credit, we shall duly honor such draft upon presentation to us, and we shall forfeit the amount of the draft to the State Oil and Gas Program of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation in accordance with your instructions.

We certify that the wording of this letter of credit is identical to the wording provided us by the State Oil and Gas Program of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation.
