Are you looking for an opportunity to work with Tennessee State Parks? Our Tennessee State Parks are among the most beautiful parks in the United States. We have an outstanding opportunity to work in a beautiful and cooperative work environment. This position is located at TO Fuller State Park in Memphis, TN. The Park has both primitive and R.V. campgrounds, 2 bathhouses, a visitor's center, interpretive center, picnic shelters, and other day use facilities. The Conservation Worker 1 works with a maintenance team on daily work assignments that change with the seasons spanning from removing trees in the roads after storms to cleaning restrooms during heavy visitor traffic, along with inventory and safety reporting.

This position is responsible for custodial and maintenance work of average to moderate difficulty. We are seeking a team player who is comfortable interacting with guests of the park and providing quick response to their custodial needs. The position requires the ability to work on some weekends and holidays and working in all weather conditions. The preferred candidate will have at least High School Diploma or GED; additional certifications welcome. Professional development opportunities available. ### Highlighted Responsibilities:

- Operate a variety of custodial related tools and equipment including washing machines, riding mowers, park vehicles, chainsaws, vacuums.
- Report repairs and safety concerns as well as request supplies needed in the facilities. Perform light maintenance of the equipment utilized.
- Remove trash from the grounds surrounding the facilities.
- Clean bathhouses, shelters, and other facilities.
- Assist Park Ranger staff in clearing and maintaining trails.
- Maintain roadways through litter pick-up and grass management.
- Partner with Park Ranger on resource management efforts such as native grass maintenance for the Wildlife Habitat Area, tree planting and park beautification efforts, etc.
