It's Invoice Season! A time of thanks! And giving!

To perform x-ray inspections as a RI, it is not sufficient to be approved by DRH. Per SRPAR [0400-20-10-.24\(3\)\(b\)](#), an RI must also pay an “annual registration fee” of \$850. This fee is usually invoiced on November 1 with a due date of December 15. This year TDEC has switched to a new financial system. Although the invoices have been generated, there may be delays in the process of physically mailing the RI invoices. If you have not received an invoice by December, please contact the RI team, and your invoice can be emailed to you. Thank you for your patience.

1. Online Payment — The preferred method using the new TDEC Customer Portal! Go to <https://tdeccustomerportal.tdec.tn.gov/>
2. Credit Card Form — Complete and return the credit card form included with your invoice.
3. Physical Check — Make the check payable to "Treasurer, State of Tennessee" and include your Customer ID number on the check. Then mail both the check and the above portion of the invoice to:
