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List above each dental professional who exposes radiographs, other than dentists or dental hygienists. **If the operator is a registered dental assistant (RDA), they must also hold a dental radiology certification from the state.** Dental assistants who are not registered as dental assistants with dental radiology certification, may not legally expose radiographs [i.e. certified dental assistant (CDA) and practical dental assistants (PDA)]. **Rule 0460-04-.11 (4) states that registered dental assistants with radiology certification shall prominently display their current registration certification, which is received upon registration and renewal, at their place of employment.** The dental radiology certification is also listed on the back of their wallet card and on the lower left corner of the 5 x 7 certificate of the dental assistant registration. If any operator exposes radiographs without a dental radiology certification as registered dental assistant (RDA), or the operator’s RDA Registration Number is not available, forward a copy of this form to the Inspection Tracking Administrator (ITA) along with initial notification of inspection. The ITA will log these reports and route through the I & E manager for referral to Health Related Boards (HRB).
