For more than 15 years, the Department of Energy (DOE) has operated an engineered disposal facility on the Oak Ridge Reservation. That facility has allowed DOE to make tremendous progress addressing environmental cleanup needs and transforming Oak Ridge.

As the current facility nears full capacity, DOE needs a new engineered disposal facility to complete the Oak Ridge Reservation's remaining cleanup—while remaining committed to sending the most highly contaminated waste out of state for disposal.

This meeting provides an opportunity to discuss the proposed plan for this project, what material and debris might be placed in the facility, and what it means for Oak Ridge's cleanup if a new facility is not built.
